To Whom It May Concern:

In response to your request for a Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) please be informed that an MSDS is not required, by law, for this product, pursuant to Occupational Health and Safety Administration regulations. Specifically, section 29 CFR 1910.1200 (b) (6) (iv) indicates that "articles" are not applicable to the Hazard Communication section (1910.1200) of the OSHA regulation.
